- How do we overcome the pain and agony of betrayal? When a spouse has hurt us with adultery or pornography, or other addictions? Where is the Justice?
 - Can't I just divorce them? Why NOT?

dies for us on the cross!

- The Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist
 - The Catholic Church has proclaimed the truth of Jesus' real presence in the Blessed Sacrament for the past 2 millennia without interruption. We know it to be true based on A) Jesus' own words, and action, in the Gospels. B) St. Paul's clear understanding of the Eucharist (i.e. in 1 Corinthians 10, and elsewhere) and C) the clear teaching, and understanding of the Church Fathers, dating back to the 1st century, attesting to the Catholic teaching on the Eucharist. In fact we don't see any "nay-sayers" to this doctrine until the Protestant revolt in the 1500's.... so, 1500 years with firm teaching on this doctrine, then we see some reject it. Jesus is the NEW Moses who leads the people of the NEW Israel through the wilderness to the NEW promised land (heaven), through the NEW waters of the Jordan (Baptism). If the OLD Moses had miraculous bread from heaven to feed the people daily... then how much more would the NEW Moses give miraculous bread from heaven? Looking at John 6 it become clear that this is in fact how Jesus intends for

us to see it. Like the Israelites who "murmured" against Moses in the wilderness... in John 6:41 the Jews are murmuring again Jesus on the NEW Manna! Jesus goes on to make it even MORE clear:

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- [49] Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died.
- [50] This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that a man may eat of it and not die.
- [51] I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live for ever; and the bread which I shall give for the life of the world is my flesh."

- If this NEW Manna is simply a "symbol", then that would make the Old Testament Manna, which DID come from heaven, greater than the new... that simply makes no sense what so ever.... the OLD could never be greater than the NEW.

 - St. Stephan Also called the Pharisees & Patriarch's Father: Acts 7:2] And Stephen said: "Brethren and fathers, hear me. The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopota'mia, before he lived in Haran,
 - St. Paul Calls himself a Father of Timothy: Philippians 2:[22] But Timothy's worth you know, how as a son with a father he has served with me in the gospel.
 - Also of Onesimus: Philemon [10] I appeal to you for my child, Ones'imus, whose father I have become in my imprisonment.
 - St. John also referees to the "elders" as Father's: 1 John 2:[13] I am writing to you, fathers, because you know him who is from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one. I write

to you, children, because you know the Father. [14] I write to you, fathers, because you know him who is from the beginning. I write to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

- What About St. Peter? He referred to Mark as his son: 1 Peter 5:13 BUT... we see his roll as the NEW Prime Minister of the Kingdom, Matthew 16, through the lens of the OLD Prim Minister...
 - Isaiah 22:
 - [15] Thus says the Lord GOD of hosts,
 "Come, go to this steward, to Shebna, who is over the household, and say to him:
 - [16] What have you to do here and whom have you here, that you have hewn here a tomb for yourself, you who hew a tomb on the height, and carve a habitation for yourself in the rock?
 - [17] Behold, the LORD will hurl you away violently, O you strong man. He will seize firm hold on you,
 - [18] and whirl you round and round, and throw you like a ball into a wide land; there you shall die, and there shall be your splendid chariots, you shame of your master's house.

- [19] I will thrust you from your office, and you will be cast down from your station.
- [20] In that day I will call my servant Eli'akim the son of Hilki'ah,
- [21] and I will clothe him with your robe, and will bind your girdle on him, and will commit your authority to his hand; and he shall be a *father* to the inhabitants of Jerusalem and to the house of Judah.
- [22] And I will place on his shoulder the key of the house of David; he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.
- [23] And I will fasten him like a peg in a sure place, and he will become a throne of honor to his father's house.
- [24] And they will hang on him the whole weight of his father's house, the offspring and issue, every small vessel, from the cups to all the flagons.
- [25] In that day, says the LORD of hosts, the peg that was fastened in a sure place will give way; and it will be cut down and fall, and the burden that was upon it will be cut off, for the LORD has spoken."
- So... did Jesus not understand what HE himself

meant in Matthew 23? Or what about HIS deciples?

- OR....
- Maybe he was NOT speaking LITERALLY but, rather figuratively?
 - Trying to communicate to us that God is the REAL deal... everything down here is a mere shadow of the reality!
 - IF we, as FATHER's are NOT leading our CHILDREN to the TRUE Father... then we are certainly NOT Father's but, rather... stumbling blocks!
