## We lack understanding of the power of suffering:

- We look at everything from a purely human perspective and fail to see the redemptive, remedial, power of suffering & penance!
  - What was Adam expected to do in Gen. 3 when Satan intruded?
    - Stand in the Gap... to lay down his life! To suffer for his bride & to remain in the Grace in which he was created!
  - What Adam failed to do... Isaac was ready to do... offer up HIS life in obedience to the Father, through Abraham!
    - But an Angel would stay his hand & God would provide HIMSELF a lamb for the sacrifice!
  - Why did God lead His first born son, Israel, out of the slavery of Egypt into the wilderness?
    - To suffer? To Die? To starve to death?
      - NO! But, the people "grumbled" and complained constantly thinking JUST that!
      - To PURGE them, to purify THEM ... to prepare them to cross through the waters and enter into the promised land... the KINGDOM which they were promised!
  - Why did God send Jonah to call the Assyrians to conversion?
    - Because he would need them to bring penance upon His first born son... Israel!
      - IF they would NOT go out and bring in all

others sons back to God...

- He would send them out through exile, through a conquering and subjection of a foreign invader!

- Through Jesus' suffering we can find the answer to

the question...

- What is the meaning to life?
  - LOVE
    - God is Love! 1 John 4:8
  - Jesus said John 14: [15] "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.
  - John 13: [34] A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. [35] By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."
  - John 15: [12] "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. [13] Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. [14] You are my friends if you do what I command you.
- Love requires you to sacrifice!
  - Colossians 1:[24] Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I complete what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the sake of his body, that is, the church, [25] of which I became a minister according to the divine office which was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known,
- Christ, the NEW Joshua, prepares us to cross from the wilderness, through the waters of Baptism, into the promised land... the Kingdom of God, which is Heaven & the beatific vision!
  - But...
    - Nothing unclean will enter it! Revelation 21!
  - So...

- We must be purified through fire! 1 Cor. 3
- Like our Lord who willingly chose to be obedient to His Father... and drink the 4th cup! So must we be willing to accept the purifying desert of this life so we can look forward to an eternity in the next!
  - John 18:[10] Then Simon Peter, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's slave and cut off his right ear. The slave's name was Malchus.
    [11] Jesus said to Peter, "Put your sword into its sheath; shall I not drink the cup which the Father has given me?"
- St. Stephen Acts 7: [54] Now when they heard these things they were enraged, and they ground their teeth against him. [55] But he, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God; [56] and he said, "Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing at the right hand of God." [57] But they cried out with a loud voice and stopped their ears and rushed together upon him. [58] Then they cast him out of the city and stoned him; and the witnesses laid down their garments at the feet of a young man named Saul. [59] And as they were stoning Stephen, he prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." [60] And he knelt down and cried with a loud voice, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." And when he had said this, he fell asleep.
  - St. Ignatius of Antioch:
    - Chapter 6. Ignatius is devoured by the beasts at Rome
- They pushed forth therefore from the place which is called Portus; and (the fame of all relating to the holymartyr being already spread abroad) we met the brethren full of fear and joy; rejoicing indeed

because they were thought worthy to meet with Theophorus, but struck with fear because so eminent a man was being led to death. Now he enjoined some to keep silence who, in their fervent zeal, were saying that they would appear the people, so that they should not demand the destruction of this just one. He being immediately aware of this through the Spirit, and having saluted them all, and begged of them to show a true affection towards him, and having dwelt [on this point] at greater length than in his Epistle, and having persuaded them not to envy him hastening to the Lord, he then, after he had, with all the brethren kneeling [beside him], entreated the Son of God in behalf of the Churches, that a stop might be put to the persecution, and that mutual love might continue among the brethren, was led with all haste into the amphitheatre. Then, being immediately thrown in, according to the command of Cæsar given some time ago, the public spectacles being just about to close (for it was then asolemn day, as they deemed it, being that which is called the thirteenth in the Roman tongue, on which the people were wont to assemble in more than ordinary numbers ), he was thus cast to the wild beasts close beside the temple, that so by them the desire of the holy martyr Ignatius should be fulfilled, according to that which is written, "The desire of the righteous is acceptable Proverbs 10:24 [to God]," to the effect that he might not be troublesome to any of the brethren by the gathering of his remains, even as he had in his Epistle expressed a wish beforehand that so his end

might be. For only the harder portions of his holy remains were left, which were conveyed to Antioch and wrapped in linen, as an inestimable treasure left to the holy Church by the grace which was in the martyr.

## - St. Polycarp:

- CHAPTER XIV -- THE PRAYER OF POLYCARP.
- They did not nail him then, but simply bound him. And he, placing his hands behind him, and being bound like a distinguished ram [taken] out of a great flock for sacrifice, and prepared to be an acceptable burnt-offering unto God, looked up to heaven, and said, "O Lord God Almighty, the Father of thy beloved and blessed Son Jesus Christ, by whom we have received the knowledge of Thee, the God of angels and powers, and of every creature, and of the whole race of the righteous who live before thee, I give Thee thanks that Thou hast counted me, worthy of this day and this hour, that I should have a part in the number of Thy martyrs, in the cup of thy Christ, to the resurrection of eternal life, both of soul and body, through the incorruption [imparted] by the Holy Ghost. Among whom may I be accepted this day before Thee as a fat and acceptable sacrifice, according as Thou, the ever-truthful God, hast fore-ordained, hast revealed beforehand to me, and now hast fulfilled. Wherefore also I praise Thee for all things, I bless Thee, I glorify Thee, along with the everlasting and heavenly Jesus Christ, Thy beloved Son, with whom, to Thee, and the Holy Ghost, be glory both now and to all coming ages. Amen."
  - So... what is the meaning of life? to LOVE as God Loves...
    - which means you sacrifice...
    - you join your sufferings to Christ on the cross
    - You give ultimate meaning to your own suffering when you

see them in light of Calvary....

- Don't avoid pain, and discomfort... embrace it for it prepares you for heaven!
